BYLAW NO. 79/88

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BULYEA TO PROVIDE FOR
PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS.


The Council of the Village of Bulyea, in the Province
of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General
Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
2. Section 3 applies only to an infraction of a
bylaw of the municipality for which no other
fine is provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any
individual found guilty of an infraction of a
bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority
of the Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to
a fine of not more than \$ 2,000.00 and costs
for every offence.
4. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any
corporation found guilty of an infraction of a
bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority
of the Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable
to a fine of not more than \$ 5,000.00 and costs
for every offence.
5. This bylaw shall come into effect May 14, 1988.
