## Bin Information Sheet

### Recycling

*Blue Bins* (3 yard, 4 yard, 6 yard, Roll-Off Single Stream)

Recycling is available for Last Mountain Regional Landfill members. Please be respectful and only put allowable items in the bins. In the Loraas Recycle's single stream recycling program (see attached flyer) only household packaging materials are allowable, these include:

- Cardboard/Boxboard/Office Paper Newsprint/ Junk Mail/Magazines/Catalogues
- Plastic Containers, Milk Cartons and Plastic Milk Jugs (Plastics numbered 1 through 7 (No "Clam Shell" Type Food Containers labelled #1))
- Household Tin/Household Aluminum

In a week long audit completed in February 2020, of the items received in the recycle facility, 30% were accepted and 70% not-accepted.

Please DO NOT put the following items in your recycle bin:

1. Human Bodily Fluid Contaminated Items (diapers, hygiene products, masks and gloves)
2. Sharps (needles, razors)
3. Aerosols

The cost to recycle will continue to increase if this isn't managed and without a recycling program, our landfill will reach capacity much quicker and waste fees will go up. Do your part to recycle appropriately.

### Waste

*Red Bins* (3 yard, 4 yard, 6 yard or 30 yard Roll-Off) are designed for standard household and yard waste ONLY.

Prohibited items include but are not limited to:

- Furniture (sofas, mattresses, dressers, tables, large chairs/recliners)
  - Small items like stools, night stands, etc. are ok
- Large appliances (refrigerators, freezers, washer/dryer)
  - Small appliances like lamps, toasters, etc. are ok
- Dead animals and carcasses
- Hazardous Waste (any new or used oils, hydraulic fluids, filters, propane tanks, paint, solvents or any item that contains such products like lawn mowers, and anything containing Freon unless previously decommissioned) and Liquid Waste
- Construction Materials (shingles, brick/concrete, gravel and any items in length greater than 4 feet)
- Tires
- Biomedical Waste
- Petroleum Hydrocarbon (PHC) Contaminated Soils and Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCB's)
- Paint
- Pesticide Containers

*Curbside Black Carts* are designed for standard household and yard waste ONLY and must be bagged.
