

# CEMETERY BYLAW

## VILLAGE OF BULYEA

### BYLAW NO 04/22

#### A BYLAW TO PROVIDE REGULATIONS FOR THE USE, CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE BULYEA CEMETERY

The council of the VILLAGE OF BULYEA, in the province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known as the “Cemetery Bylaw”.
2. “Council” in this bylaw shall mean the Council of the Village of Bulyea.
3. That the land described as: the North West Quarter of Section Twenty-Seven (27), in Township Twenty-Nine (29), in Range Twenty-Two (22), West of the Second (2<sup>nd</sup>) Meridian, lying East of Highway 20 as shown in Plan No A FY 1870, has been appropriated as a Public Cemetery to be called “Bulyea Cemetery”.
4. A person may reserve grave plots by paying in full the current purchase price of \$250.00 as established by the Cemetery Committee.
5. A fee of \$100.00 to be charged to put a cremation urn on an existing plot, where be a casket and an urn or a second urn on the same plot.
6. The fee to dig the cremation hole to be \$75.00 paid to the Bulyea Cemetery.
7. Grave covers, decorative stone, fences, borders or similar ornamentation that protrudes above ground level shall not be allowed on any graves.
8. The purchaser of a grave plot shall observe all rules and regulations passed from time to time by Council or Cemetery Committee for keeping grave plots in order.
9. Persons visiting the Cemetery or attending a funeral are strictly prohibited from picking flowers, wild or cultivated, breaking or injuring any tree, shrub or plant, or from writing upon, defacing, or injuring any structure within the Cemetery grounds.
10. Motor cars and vehicles in the Cemetery shall travel only on the roadways, provided for that purpose, except those vehicles used for the performance of maintenance.
11. A valid business license is required by those businesses carrying out any work in the cemetery.
12. General maintenance and upkeep shall be the responsibility of the Cemetery Committee as described in Bylaw No. 01/13.
13. The Cemetery Committee shall have the authority to:
  - a. Remove all floral designs, flowers, weeds, trees, shrubs, plants or herbage of any kind from the Cemetery as they become unsightly, dangerous, detrimental or diseased.

- b. Remove or repair any tombstone, monument or other structures placed or arranged in the cemetery that are in a state of disrepair if the purchaser does not make the required repairs or alterations within three (3) months of being given notice. The cost of the removal or repair of such structure, tombstone, or monument shall be charged to the purchaser of said grave plot. All notice required to be given to the purchaser of grave plots or owners of monuments shall be delivered in writing by the Village Administrator and/or designated individual.
- 14. Council or Cemetery Committee shall not be held responsible for replacement and/or repair of any tombstone, monument, markers or other structure that has been vandalized, damaged or in a state of repair.
- 15. Any persons found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of the Bylaw, shall be liable to penalties imposed by the Village of Bulyea.
- 16. Bylaw 02/13 is hereby repealed.
