A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE VEHICLE WEIGHTS AND TRUCK ROUTES IN THE VILLAGE OF BULYEA

The council of the village of Bulyea in the province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as the truck route by law.
2. Interpretation:
 - A. **“Heavy vehicle”** means a vehicle with or without load, which alone or together with any trailer, semi trailer or other vehicle being towed, weighs **1 TON** or more, but not including recreational vehicles or emergency vehicles.
 - B. **“Highway”** means a road, parkway, driveway, square, or place designed and intended or used by the public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area and does not include a provincial highway within the municipality as designated pursuant to the provisions of *The Highways and Transportation Act*;
 - C. **“Municipality”** means the village of Bulyea.
 - D. **“Vehicle”** means a vehicle, trailer or semi trailer or motor vehicle as ascribed to it by the *Highways and Transportation Act*.
3. Infractions:
 - A. Weight restrictions-Truck route-
 - (1) No person will operate a heavy vehicle within the municipality or a combination of vehicles when the combined gross weight of the vehicle, with or without a load, exceeds 1 Ton. **Except on Lorri Lane and Railway Ave.** Where truck route sign allows and as shown in schedule “A” attached to this Bylaw.

- (2) Subject to subsection 1. No person will operate a heavy vehicle within the municipality or combination of vehicles when the combined gross weight of the vehicle, with or without a load, exceeds the maximum allowable weight pursuant to the Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations 2024 on any highway within the municipality.
- (3) The provisions of the Police Act and the Highways and Transportation Act will apply to the operators of vehicles referred to in this by law.
- (4) In the case of a ratepayer operating or hiring a heavy vehicle; where they must use other streets or avenues to access their property, Council authorizes operation for heavy vehicle traffic under 5000 kg on all other highways within the municipality.
- (5) Any damages that may be made to the municipality roadways while operating overweight vehicles subject to subsection 4. will be the responsibility of the driver of such vehicle.

4. Penalties:

- A. (1) A person who contravenes the provisions of subsection 2A is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a penalty of \$500.00 to the first offense and \$1000.00 for each offense following.

Bylaw No.03-01, passed October 18th, 2001, being a bylaw To Regulate The Weight And/Or Dimensions Of Vehicles, is hereby repealed.

This bylaw will come into effect on the day of its final passing.
